The hearings of the Judicial Commission of Inquiry into Allegations of State Capture, Corruption and Fraud in the Public Sector including Organs of State will continue on 14 March 2019 at 09h30.

The Commission will continue to hear Eskom related testimony from former business rescue practitioner of Optimum coal mine, Mr. Piers Marsden and former Director General of the Department of Mineral Resources, Dr Thibedi Ramontja on 14 March 2019. The Commission will also hear testimony of former Finance Minister, Mr Nhlanhla Nene. Mr Nhlanhla Nene will complete his evidence on 14 March 2019. The legal team is in the process of identifying and/or consulting with other witness who will be called to appear before the Commission over the next few weeks.
